Entry Fees - **25p per entry** Junior section - **Free**  Staging times are on Saturday 8.00am til 10.30am

## <u>Rules</u>

1) The show will be conducted in accordance with the rules and standards contained in The Royal Horticultural Society's *Horticultural Show Handbook* 2008, except where, under this schedule, they obviously do not apply.

2) All exhibits in classes 1-50 must have been grown by the exhibitor and have been in their possession for at least eight weeks prior to the show.

3) A novice is defined as an exhibitor who has won less than one first prize in any show.

4) An exhibitor may not enter more than 2 exhibits in any one class.

5) Entries must be received by the Committee no later than Thursday 15th August 6.00pm. No late entries will be received.

6) The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and settle any matter not provided for in the rules.

7) Staging Times – Saturday 8.00am – 10.30am.

8) Class cards - these must be obtained from the Show Secretary on arrival for staging. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that these are correctly place with the exhibit in the appropriate class. **Exhibits without a card will not be judged.** 

9) Highest number of points for awards of trophies - in arriving at highest number of points, 3 will be awarded for 1st prize, 2 for 2nd prize and 1 for 3rd prize.

10) Exhibits must not be removed until the end of the show at 3.00pm.

11) Whilst every reasonable precaution is taken to safeguard all exhibits and vases, The Committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage.

12) The Judges decision is final.

13) All trophies awarded on the day must be returned to the committee by  $1^{st}$  July 2020.

#### Show Day timetable

8am-10.30am – Staging

10.30am-12.00pm - Judging

From 12.00pm– Marquee open (this may change depending on the amount of entries and the time it takes to judge)

2.30pm - Presentation of awards, at the picnic area

3.00pm - Exhibits to be removed

The exhibitor who wins the most points in the show will be awarded with a Shield and will receive £30.

A shield will be presented for Best Plot at Ashfield (the winner of the Liverpool Allotments Competition) and will receive  $\pounds 20$ .

A trophy will be presented for the winner of 'The Best Newcomer' (winner will be voted by plotholders) and will receive  $\pounds 20$ .

#### **Vegetable Section**

The winner of most points in the vegetable section will be awarded the Liverpool City Council Trophy and £20.

1) Three onions each to be 250g or Under, dressed

- 2) Three onions large over 250g, dressed
- 3) Dish of five shallots
- 4) Dish of three potatoes, white
- 5) Dish of three potatoes, other than white
- 6) Dish of four potatoes, 2 white, 2 other than white
- 7) Six Tomatoes, cherry or other small cultivar
- 8) Three Tomatoes, Medium sized
- 9) Dish of six runner beans
- 10) Dish of six french beans
- 11) Longest runner bean
- 12) Three Globe beetroot, tops trimmed to 3 inches
- 13) One Sweetcorn cob
- 14) One Cucumber
- 15) Three Courgettes, Max size 6 inches
- 16) Three sticks of rhubarb, trimmed
- 17) Three carrots, tops trimmed to 3 inches
- 18) One Cabbage with clean roots
- 19) One Dish of Soft Fruit
- 20) One Dish of Non-Soft fruit
- 21) Three Herbs, Named in Water
- 22) Heaviest Onion, with roots & foliage
- 23) Heaviest Marrow
- 24) One Squash
- 25) Most unusual shaped vegetable
- 26) Any other Vegetable not mentioned in the schedule
- 27) Salad Tray, 4 types of salad in a seed tray 8" x 12"

28) Vegetable Tray, A selection of 3 types of vegetables from the following list, quantities of each in Brackets
Potatoes (3) Onions (3) Carrots (3) Runner Beans (6)
French Beans (6) Cauliflower (1) Tomatoes (6)
Pods of Peas (6) Cabbage (1) *Tray not to exceed 45cm by 60cm*

29) **NOVICE** - One vegetable tray, three different types of vegetables

#### **Flower Section**

The winner of the most points in the Flower Section will be awarded a trophy and  $\pounds 20$ .

- 30) One vase, Three Dahlias any variety or varieties
- 31) One vase, One Dahlia, any variety
- 32) One vase of annuals, mixed, maximum of 15 stems
- 33) One vase of annuals, one variety, maximum 10 stems
- 34) One vase of perennials, maximum of 15 stems
- 35) One vase of flowers, for fragrance, any variety or varieties
- 36) One vase of sweet peas, any variety or varieties, 9 stems
- 37) One vase, one spike of Gladioli
- 38) One vase of Chrysanthemums. 1 spray,
- 39) One pot plant flowering, max 8" pot
- 40) NOVICE One vase of flowers

### **Baking and Preserves Section**

The winner of the most points in the Baking and Preserves section will be awarded a trophy and £20.

This sections is also open to Plotholders family.

- 41) Five Cup Cakes, decorated
- 42) One Chocolate Cake, decorated
- 43) One plate of 5 Brownies
- 44) One Jar of Homemade Chutney
- 45) One Jar of Homemade Jam, berry fruit
- 46) One Jar of Homemade Jam, other than berry fruit
- 47) One Jar of Homemade Jelly
